## Instruction to the Candidates for Proficiency test in Stenography vide Advertisement number 1/2025-REC

- Candidates are required to report at the exam centre at the reporting time indicated on their Admit Card. The candidate must bring his/her original ID proof (Aadhar card/ Voter ID/ Passport etc) along with the admit card etc.
- 2. Travelling and other expenses must be borne by the candidates themselves.
- 3. Candidates are required to bring original copies of the following certificates/documents at the examination centre.
  - Matriculation or equivalent certificate in support of date of birth.
  - ii. Education Certificate in support of educational qualifications.
  - iii. SC/ST/Ex-Serviceman/OBC/PH certificate in the 'PRESCRIBED' format issued by the competent authority, in case candidate belongs to any such category.
  - iv. "No Objection Certificate" if the candidate is already employed.
  - v. Two recent passport size photographs.
- 4. Candidates bring Pen, Pencil, eraser etc. with them.
- 5. The candidates will be required to take their seat ten minutes before commencement of the Stenography Test.
- 6. Candidate should listen to the instruction given by invigilator carefully before commencement of test and should follow the same. Else they may be disqualified.
- 7. Candidates shall not be permitted to leave the Examination Hall until the expiry of the Test.
- 8. Silence must be observed in the Examination Hall. Smoking /chewing tobacco in the Examination Hall is strictly prohibited.
- 9. On completion of the test, the candidates shall remain seated at their desks and wait for further instructions.
- 10. Candidates should not take any paper out of the Examination Hall.
- 11. Candidates must abide by further instructions, if any, which may be given to them by the Invigilator/Supervisor. If any fails to do so or indulges in disorderly or improper conduct, he / she will render himself / herself liable to expulsion from the test.
- 12. Any request for change in time/date/centre/medium of the test will not be entertained under any circumstances.
- 13. Candidates should not tear any sheet given to them. When the printout of the transcript typed by him/her is given to him/her, he/she must write his roll no. on each page, signature, and handover the same to the invigilator along with the Shorthand Note book.
- 14. Possession of mobile / cellular phones / Smart watch or any communication gadgets (whether in use or not) in the examination hall is strictly prohibited.
